Philippines, Brunei sign double taxation agreement seen to generate investments, create jobs

Department of Finance (DOF) Secretary Carlos G. Dominguez of the Philippines and Yang Berhormat Dato Seri Setia Dr. Awang Haji Mohd Amin Liew bin Abdullah, the Minister at the Prime Minister's Office and Minister of Finance and Economy II of Brunei Darussalam hold their copies of the double taxation agreement they signed on behalf of their respective governments this morning, July 16, 2021, in Brunei's capital city of Bandar Seri Begawan. The Philippines-Brunei Agreement for the Avoidance of Double Taxation and the Prevention of Fiscal Evasion With Respect To Taxes on Income aims to further ease trade in goods and services, and enhance investment flows and economic activity between the countries. The agreement is also expected to create more jobs for Filipinos both in the Philippines and in Brunei.

EDITORIAL:

With friends like these

"Lest we are misunderstood, let us be clear." A month ago, Chinese President Xi Jinping said he wants China to "expand its circle of friends" by re-vamping its image.

Xi told senior Communist Party officials it was important to present an image of a "credible, lovable and respectable China," a report by the state-run Xinhua news agency said.

In light of these words, we respectfully suggest that China stop dumping human waste and sewage into the West Philippine Sea.

And, oh yes, we also ask—as a friend, of course—that China refrain from dismissing "as a piece of waste paper" Manila's hard-earned legal victory over Beijing before the UN Permanent Court of Arbitration, which five years ago upheld the Philippines' exclusive economic zone in the West Philippine Sea.

These are not the actions of a friend. These are not the actions of a "credible, lovable and respectable" member of the international community.

Yet here we are, amid Beijing's bleating about amity, struggling to deal with a disrespectful and even bellicose neighbor.

Similarity, which specializes in geospatial

analysis and provides satellite data imagery, reported this week that Chinese ships have been dumping raw sewage every day for several years on reefs, creating harmful Chlorophyll-a blooms in the waters.

"It is so intense you can see it from space," said Liz Derr, Similarity CEO.

Showing satellite images in the last five years, Derr said effluent from Chinese ships are causing elevated concentrations of Chlorophyll—a leading to "a cascade of reef damage that will take decades to recover even with active mitigation."

"When the ships don't move, the poop piles up," she said. "The damage to the reefs in the last five years is visible and dramatic."

Beijing, meanwhile, used the fifth anniversary of the Philippines' legal victory before the PCA—acknowledged by the rest of the world—to dismiss the UN tribunal's decision as a "piece of waste paper." If that sounds eerily familiar, it's perhaps because these were the same words that our own President used to describe the arbitral ruling in Manila's favor.

In an attempt to counterbalance this atrocious behavior, Beijing has engaged in vaccine diplomacy, donating and selling us vaccines to deal with a global pandemic that started in its own country. We appreciate the help—but that doesn't excuse the boorish lack of regard the Chinese are showing us. Lest we are misunderstood, let us be clear.

Hey, China, stop pooping in our backyard—and show a little respect, will you? With friends like you, who needs enemies?

SM Supermalls marks 1 millionth COVID-19 vaccine dose

The one-millionth dose came almost four months to the day since the first person received their COVID vaccine in an SM mall. To date, there are 62 SM malls nationwide that serve as venues for the vaccination program of various LGUs in the Philippines.

127th Malasakit Center launched in Bacoor City as Bong Go continues efforts to improve public health delivery to cater to the medical needs of Filipinos



PASAY CITY -- Senator Christopher "Bong" Go personally attended the launch of the country's 127th Malasakit Center at the Southern Tagalog Regional Hospital in Bacoor City, Cavite on Wednesday, July 7.

Go cited that the establishment of more Malasakit Centers is part of the Duterte Administration's commitment to bring government closer to the people and improve public health delivery to those in need especially amid an ongoing pandemic.

This Malasakit Center is the 11th in the CALABARZON region and second in the province, in addition to the General Emilio Aguinaldo Memorial Hospital in Trece Martires City which opened last January 2020.

In his remarks, the Senator—who serves as Chair of the Senate Committee on Health—described the challenges faced by low-income patients in getting access to quality healthcare. He lamented that Filipinos living in poor areas often forego medical care or end up financially burdened due to medical expenses.

"Nung wala pa ang Malasakit Center, kailangang pang lumapit ng mga pasyente sa iba't ibang opisina ng gobyerno para magmakaawa na tulungan sila. Lunes, pipila 'yan sa city hall para humingi ng tulong kay mayor, Martes sa PhilHealth at Miyerkules sa (Philippine Charity Sweepstakes Office)," began Go.

"Bakit ba natin sila pinapahirapan? Bakit kailangan pa nilang magmakaawa sa gobyerno kung pera naman nila 'yan? Kaya isinulong ko sa Senado para maging batas 'to para kahit wala na kami ni Pangulong Rodrigo Duterte ay tuloy-tuloy lang ang programang ito," he continued.

To address the need for an efficient integrated system for conveniently availing medical assistance, Go principally authored and sponsored the Malasakit Centers Act which the President signed into law in December 2019.

The center is a one-stop shop which streamlines the process of acquiring aid from the relevant agencies, namely PhilHealth, PCSO, the Department of Health, and the Department of Social Welfare and Development. It seeks to reduce a hospital bill to the lowest possible amount by covering various patient services and expenses.

"Isa lang pakiusap ko sa mga susunod na administrasyon, sana ipagpatuloy niyo ang mga programa gaya ng Malasakit Center dahil nakakatulung naman ito sa mga mahihirap. Bihira naman na pupunta sa mga pampublikong ospital ang mga mayayaman. Ang pumupunta dito ang mga mahihirap at walang matakbuhan," said Go.

The Senator reminded the hospital staff to provide their poor patients with the necessary treatments and medical attention. He especially asked them to properly use government funds to provide sufficient care to

those needing tests and medication. He promised to continue looking after the welfare of medical workers and health professionals.

"Bukas ang aking opisina sa lahat ng medical frontliners. Kung may reklamo kayo o may hindi sang-ayon sa inyo, sabihan niyo lang ako at isusumbong natin 'to kay Pangulong Duterte. Tutulongan ko kayo to the best of my abilities in my capacity bilang inyong committee chair (of health) sa Senado," reassured Go.

Meanwhile, he reiterated his appeal to unvaccinated Filipinos belonging to priority sectors particularly medical frontliners to get inoculated so they can safely perform their duties. The concerned authorities, he said, have been directed to accelerate all vaccination efforts in order to move on to the next priority groups for inoculation.

"Patuloy po tayong magtiwala at mag-cooperate sa pamahalaan. Kailangan namin ang disiplinang ninyo habang patuloy tayong nagbabakuna. So far, so good naman ang overall COVID-19 response natin at rollout ng mga bakuna," explained Go.

"Pakiusap, magpabakuna na ang pwendeng magbabakuna. Basta pagdumating ito, i-deploy at iturok niyo na agad para makamtan na natin ang 'population protection' ngayong taong ito," he concluded. Following the ceremony, Go and his team handed out meals, food packs, vitamins, masks and face shields to a total of 239



medical frontliners. They also gave selected recipients new shoes or bicycles while others received computer tablets for their children's educational needs.

In addition, personnel from the DSWD also provided 131 rank-and-file hospital employees with financial assistance. Similar assistance were likewise extended to 56 indigent patients.

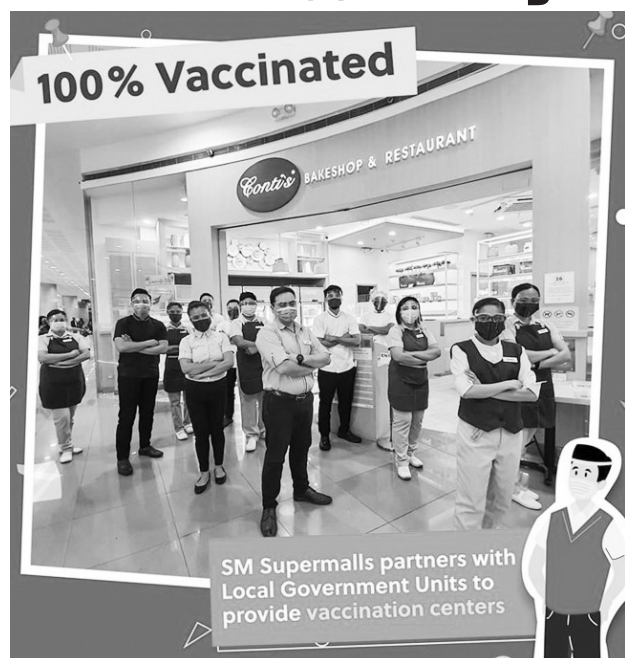

LPG safety bill breezes through bicam panel

After 18 years and seven Congresses, the bill seeking to regulate the liquefied petroleum gas (LPG) industry to ensure consumer welfare against illegally refilled and poor quality cylinders will finally be enacted into law.

The bicameral conference committee on Tuesday, July 13, approved the proposed LPG Industry Regulation Act, which will set the best conduct and practices for all domestic industry players and institutionalize the cylinder exchange and swapping program to allow consumers to purchase any LPG cylinder brand of their choice.

"With one unified LPG bill that will ultimately govern the entire LPG industry, we can now fill in the regulatory gaps that are being experienced by our industry players and strengthen the various regulations issued by the government. Most important of all, it will provide safety standards for the protection of the consumers by eliminating unsafe cylinders from circulation," the Senate Energy Committee Chairperson said.

Deliberations on the final form of the bill went smoothly as the Senate opted to adopt the House of Representatives' proposed provisions on penalties and the latter agreeing to the covered prohibited acts laid down by the upper chamber.

The reconciled version of the Senate Bill No. 1955, in which Gatchalian is the principal author, and House Bill No. 9323 likewise sets the standards for and responsibilities of LPG industry participants – importers, bulk suppliers, bulk distributors, haulers, refillers, trademark owners, marketers, dealers, and retail outlets – in complying with the stringent safety protocols.

Widely used for a variety of purposes such as heating, lighting, cooking on a daily basis for four in 10 Filipino households and even fuel for motor vehicles, Gatchalian underscored the need for a comprehensive regulatory framework to govern the industry.

"Considering the importance of LPG as a household energy source and keeping in mind its hazardous quality if left improperly regulated, it is certainly high time for this bill to finally become a law," Gatchalian said.

BANDAR SERI BEGAWAN--The Philippines and Brunei Darussalam have signed an agreement aimed at eliminating double taxation and preventing fiscal evasion on taxes on income arising from cross-border transactions between these two Southeast Asian countries.

The agreement was signed by Philippine Finance Secretary Carlos

Dominguez III and Yang Berhormat Dato Seri Setia Dr. Awang Haji Mohd Amin Liew bin Abdullah, the Minister at the Prime Minister's Office and Minister of Finance and Economy II of Brunei, this morning, July 16, on behalf of their respective governments.

Secretary Dominguez said this Agreement for the Avoidance of Double Taxation and the Pre-

vention of Fiscal Evasion With Respect To Taxes on Income (double taxation agreement or DTA) is expected to further strengthen economic cooperation and enhance investment flows and economic activity between the two countries. He assured the Philippines' commitment to continue and deepen the coordination with the tax authorities of Brunei in ensuring the proper implementation of the DTA and the enforcement of relevant tax laws.

"This agreement will serve us well as we bounce back from the ravages of the global health crisis. It will further ease trade in goods and services between

more supportive, more Philippine HEIs can internationalize faster," said CHED Chairman Popoy De Vera.

He noted that the signing of the DTA will further elevate the "close, warm and mutually beneficial" partnership between these two countries that have enjoyed strong ties since both established full diplomatic relations in 1984.

The DTA will strengthen the Philippines' commitment in the ASEAN Forum on Taxation (AFT) to complete a network of double taxation agreements among the member-states of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN).

On top of enhancing bilateral relations with Brunei, the DTA is also expected to create more jobs for Filipinos in both countries, given that addressing the adverse effects of double taxation can help bring in more foreign direct investments (FDIs) from Brunei

to the Philippines or get our workers employed in Brunei. The DTA is also expected to encourage the transfer of technology and skills between the two countries.

The Philippines and Brunei began negotiations on a DTA in 2001 in this capital city of Brunei and resumed the talks in Manila in 2010.

Following a series of negotiations and exchange of letters, a draft of the agreement was finally approved on August 5, 2017.

The DOF concurred to the signing of the DTA on May 24, 2019.

National Gov't, BARM hold back-to-back meetings to speed up implementation of Bangsamoro Organic Law

Officials of the national government and the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (BARMM) held back-to-back meetings of the Intergovernmental Relations Body (IGRB) and the Special Intergovernmental Fiscal Policy Board (IFPB) to resolve issues and fast-track the implementation of the Bangsamoro Organic Law (BOL).

Finance Secretary Carlos Dominguez III, who co-chairs both the IGRB and the IFPB, said the meetings underscore the deep commitment of both the national and Bangsamoro governments to ensure the successful implementation of a genuine and functional autonomy in the BARMM.

The latest meeting of the IGRB, which is co-chaired by BARMM Minister Mohagher Iqbal of the Ministry of Basic, Higher, and Technical Education, was the 8th held since it was first convened in Davao City in December 2019. Co-chaired by BARMM Chief Minister Ahod Ebrahim, the IFPB also held its third meeting on the same day, June 14.

"These back-to-back meetings underscore the strong partnership and cooperation between the national government and the Bangsamoro government to resolve issues on the implementation of the Bangsamoro Organic Law through regular consultation and continuing dialogue," Dominguez said.

During the 8th IGRB meeting, the co-chairs directed the body's technical working group (TWG) tasked to facilitate the purchase of the properties of the Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (ARMM) outside the BARMM to convene immediately.

The co-chairpersons said the TWG should begin work on transferring these properties outside of the BARMM to the national government.

According to Finance Undersecretary Bayani Agabin, the TWG is tasked to recommend the manner of appraising the properties and resolving issues involving their disposition.

"The TWG is tasked to find ways to speed up the disposition of the properties so that the proceeds of the sale can be used by the Bangsamoro Government for the implementation of development projects in their region," Agabin said. During the meeting, the IGRB also noted the progress of the other intergovernmental relations mechanisms provided under the BOL. "The IGRB co-chairpersons urged these bodies to convene at the soonest possible time," Agabin said.

At the IFPB meeting, the participation of the Bangsamoro government in the Southern Philippines Development Authority (SPDA) was discussed.

Agabin said that "provisionally, it
