# Let there be light

Last week, the Energy Regulatory Commission ordered—for the fourth time since last year— • the listed power distributor Manila Electric Company (Meralco) to refund to its residential customers a total P21.8 billion in overcharges.

That translates to 87 centavos per kilowatt : hour, a hefty amount—if in fact it should thus be refunded—which would mean a good financial load off the shoulders of customers.

It boggles the mind that Meralco is slower in making the refund than in imposing previously the overcharges.

The ERC, in its 68-page decision, directed 2 Meralco to reimburse residential customers the equivalent of 87 centavos per kilowatt hour (kWh), which means a typical household that consumes 200 kWh per month will see a P174 refund in the bill beginning in July and in the next 11 months for a lump sum of . P2,088.

Hopes are high among customers, who have been jabbed by the pandemic, that Meralco will implement the refund, faster, if possible than a customer can see the wall or ceiling lights even before he can press the switch on.

ERC chairperson Agnes Devanadera said : the adjustments have been made to reflect the final computation of a tariff-setting methodology by which power firms are able to collect distribution costs.

Customarily, a distribution firm is given a five-year regulator-approved formula to compute: distribution expenses — in the instant case the overcharges covered July 2015 to June 22.

Said Devanadera in a statement: "We wanted to ensure that all over-recoveries shall be refunded : complete with interest "Which is just proper.

"While we have yet to receive suppliers' billings, there is a possibility that the refund can offset the expected increase in generation charge and lead to a reduction in the overall power rates for July."

ERC earlier on ordered a refund of P13.9 bil- 2 lion in over-recoveries in January 2021, a P4.8 billion : refund in February this year, which brings the total refund for residential customers to P1.8009 per kWh.

### **ERC commendable on** order of Meralco refund

Senator Win Gatchalian commended the Energy Regulatory Commission (ERC) for ordering Manila Electric Company (MERALCO) to refund its customers P21.8 billion equivalent to 87 centavos per kilowatt-hour (kWh).

This means that for a typical household that consumes 200 kWh a month, there will be a P174 refund in the electricity bill beginning this

"This is a welcome relief especially for poor Filipino households. It will make a difference amid the rising cost of basic commodities," Gatchalian said.

Meralco had been directed to execute the refund in approximately 12 months or until the entire amount is fully reimbursed to its customers and to reflect the refund rate as a separate line item in the electricity bill during the refund period.

The refund directive is the third since January this year. The ERC said that Meralco's previous refunds are to be implemented until 2023 and the updated total refund for residential consumers is now at P1.8009/kWh to include the latest P21.8 billion refund

Gatchalian lauded the ERC for being committed in ensuring reasonable electricity rates through the exercise of prudent and equitable judgment, for protecting the welfare of consumers, and balancing the interests of all stakeholders.

The senator said that it's fortunate that the ERC's directive to reimburse residential customers came just days after the Supreme Court upheld a 2013 approved rate hike application by the country's biggest power distribution utility.

The said high court ruling granted Meralco the authority to impose a staggered power hike to recover P22.64 billion from consumers.
