The new recruits are composed of 400 Coast Guard Officer's Course trainees under Class 30, and 3,820 Coast Guard Non-Officer's Course trainees under Classes 100 to 107

The Senate Committee on Basic Education will conduct an inquiry on the MATATAG K to 10 curriculum to assess the Department of Education's (DepEd) readiness for its rollout, Senator Win Gatchalian said

The chairperson of the Senate basic education panel pressed the importance of ensuring the effective implementation of the MATATAG K-10 curriculum to improve learners' performance and reverse the country's education crisis. The pilot run of the MATATAG K-10 curriculum started on September 25 this year in 35 schools across seven regions.

Previously, Gatchalian also called on the Teacher Education Council (TEC), which the Secretary of Education chairs, to ensure the alignment of teacher education and training to the MATATAG K to 10 curriculum

The DepEd previously reiterated that the MATATAG K to 10 curriculum focuses on literacy, numeracy, and socio-emotional skills. Peace competencies are also among the features of the MATATAG K to 10 Curriculum.

The said curriculum will have a phased implementation, which will start by School Year (SY) 2024-2025 for Kindergarten, Grades 1, 4, and 7. The curriculum will roll out in Grades 2, 5, and 8 by SY 2025-2026; followed by Grades 3, 6, and 9 for SY 2026-2028. By SY 2027-2028, the revised curriculum will roll out in Grade 10, followed by the full curriculum implementation by 2028.

To further capacitate health workers in addressing the mental health gap in the region, the DOH said they will also conduct post training supervision in the community

"[Starting] the first quarter next year, we will conduct post training supervision to see if the Municipal Health Officers are practicing the mental health gap. We also need the masterlist of patients for the allocation of psychotropic drugs.

Calanog believes that although mental, neurological, and substance abuse literacy among the general public is improving, patients are still hesitant to seek professional health due to stigma

"They ashamed to seek professional help, in fear that they will be judged. Although times have changed, and mental health is freely discussed, stigma [on the issue] still exists." Calanog said

Health insti tutions have reported around 2,015 cases of mental health disorders in the region, with Laguna Province recording the highest number of reported cases with 764 followed by the provinces of Quezon (509), Cavite (278), Batangas (243), and Rizal (222). (PB)
