ASEAN is a political and economic union which promotes intergovernmental cooperation and fa- cilitates economic, political, security, educational and sociocultural integration between its members and countries in the Asia-Pacific region.

Its primary objective is to accelerate economic growth by loosening restrictions on goods, services

and capital within the region.

Another is to promote regional peace and stability based on the rule of law and the principles of the UN Charter. The regional bloc resolves issues and concerns through consensus, or what it calls "the ASEAN
